WINDY LU WHO pressed the pace three then two wide into the stretch, made the lead before the furlong marker, set the balance of the pace and just missed hanging on. MARKET SUCCESS trailed for nearly a half, swung wide and closed a gap late in the six path. BALLROOM BLITZ pressed the pace two wide into the far turn, made the lead, set the pace into the stretch then was outfinished. BETHABARA offered a mild bid along the rail into the stretch then was outfinished. FRIDAY failed to menace. PLATINUM SKY pressed the pace along the inside and was through after a half. TIZ WHAT broke in front, set the pace in the two path into the far turn then stopped.
