SOCIAL ENGAGEMENT chased the pace early, was in the five path into the lane, rallied down the lane, edged past the leaders three wide and cleared the field in the final stages. MISSION BELLE raced back early on, loomed three wide nearing the lane, made a bid near the eighth pole but hung in the late stages. HOT HEELS set the pace early, was in the two path into the lane and yielded late in the stretch run. LA TOURISTA tracked the pace early, was in the three path into the lane, made a bid down the lane but weakened late in the drive. RUNAWAY MOM raced back early on, was in the eight path into the lane and moved up in the stretch drive. MOONSHINE DREAMER was bumped and bothered at the start, raced in the six path into the lane and flattened out late in the stretch run. MACHINE GUN MERRY was never a threat. JERSEY GOLD was through after a half. LAKE BARKLEY stalked the pace early, was in the four path into the lane and faded down the lane.
