HAWK OF WAR settled off of the pace two to three wide, tracked while awaiting racing room behind a wall of rivals turning for home, tipped four wide in upper stretch while inside of RISK MANAGER, rallied to bid along with that foe at the sixteenth pole, dueled between horses through the late stages, and prevailed. RISK MANAGER trailed early on, gained five to six wide and outside of foes turning for home, sustained his charge in the final furlong while hanging on his left lead, bid at the sixteenth pole, battled through the closing stages, but missed. VINTAGE PRINT tracked from midpack along the inside,



split foes three wide turning for home to bid for the lead nearing the lane, led in upper stretch, cleared at the furlong grounds, but met a pair of bids at the sixteenth pole, and was bested. HOZIER stalked along the inside, but only managed to chase the top trio from the two path through the final furlong. ABSAM saved ground off of the pace, but to no avail. PEEKACHO tracked from midpack three to four wide, ranged up to striking distance turning for home, but yielded when put to tight quarters between horses in upper stretch. QUARI MASTER set the pace in the two path early on, but was swarmed by a host of challengers nearing the lane, and yielded in upper stretch. SOUNION tracked two wide, but faded four wide and between horses turning for home. KOUFAX bobbled at the start while still breaking with the top flight, prompted the pace from the five path around the first turn, tucked two wide while pressing down the backstretch, vied among foes nearing the lane, but weakened between horses in upper stretch. HAIG POINT never got involved.
