CODE ONE was off slowly, then saved ground. SOFT PANTS stalked the pace in the four path, then lacked a late bid. DE BERARD stalked the pace between, was steadied at the three-sixteenths pole, then lacked a late bid. TALKSCHEAP pressed the pace at the three path, faded, then drifted in at the top of the stretch, causing IRISH ACES to clip heels. ALWAYS SPRING bore in at the start and bumped a foe.
