PEOPLE FORCE raced prominently in the three path, was cued in the two path around the far turn and bid passing the quarter pole, took a narrow lead in the three path at the top of the stretch and drew clear under left handed encouragement in the final furlong for the win. MY FAVORITE TOPIC bumped with an inner foe at the start, raced in midpack in the four path, was roused in the four path around the far turn and tipped out to the six path into the stretch, and ran on under right handed urging for place. GUSTAVOR was steadied passing the wire the first time, tracked in the the three path, was roused in the four path into the far turn and took aim from the five path into the stretch, and kept on to show. SOUPERSILVERDOLLAR got bumped on both sides at the start, was in the three path around the first turn and raced wellback in the four path down the backstretch, was roused in the three path around the far turn and angled out to the seven path entering the lane, and finished evenly. PEACH NECTAR set the pace in the two path, was coaxed along the inside around the far turn, but yielded entering the final furlong. MR. AMERICAN bumped with an inner foe and an outer foe at the start, stalked in the two path, was coaxed

into the far turn, but flattened in the four path in the stretch. SOCIAL SIDEKICK had a hesitant and slow start and trailed around the three path into the far turn, and was no factor from the five path in the stretch. DONTONIO was in the three path around the first turn and settled in midfield from the four path down the backstretch, was under urging passing the quarter pole, and was empty in the stretch. CYCLONE RANGER bumped with an inner foe and then brushed with an outer foe just after, rated in the six path, was in the four path around the far turn, but was no threat in the six path in the stretch. ETRETAT bumped with an outer foe at the start, was unhurried along the inside of rivals but was never a menace.
