SUE ELLEN MISHKIN broke sharp, showed the way up the backstretch, shrugged off two foes into lane, long drive, determined. SUPER WONDER GIRL broke back, raced back and inside through the turn, rallied up the rail to finish up willingly, nod for the place. SUMMER SHOES forwardly placed in the run up the backstretch, closer four wide to press through the turn, lost ground to the winner into the stretch, rebid a furlong out, hung late, nipped for the place. PISTOL forwardly placed along the rail, two path into the lane, lacked the needed closing response. LOFTHOUSE void of speed, encountered some traffic late in the turn, improved position when clear for the drive. OFF RAMP lacked speed between rivals, four wide into the lane while also encountering some traffic, improved slightly as well. SECRET FIX forwardly placed, advanced and challenged between horses in the turn, faltered in the drive. PIPELINE GIRL mid pack, tired while racing in the two path through the turn. SAND AND SEA four wide and off the pace into the turn, had nothing for the drive. BLACK KAT TAPS last away, raced four out to five wide turn, remained back. LADY GOLDSTART flashed brief early foot and stopped.
