CYCLONE RANGER was bumped hard just after the start then pinched back soon after, trailed inside early, advanced inside around the far turn, angled four wide near the quarter pole, closed outside and was up late. MUFRIH settled off the pace while racing two wide between foes, advanced three wide around the far turn, seized command leaving the quarter pole, quickly cleared, continued on the left lead in the lane, drifted in then out and was caught late. I'LLSMILEAGAIN was bumped soon after the start, raced off the pace inside, moved up two wide around the far turn, continued on the left lead in the lane and rallied inside. BREAK THE ICE saved ground in range and lacked a closing bid. SECRET POCKET veered in at the start and bumped the winner into other foes, raced two wide and never threatened. NORFIE disputed the pace two wide, drew clear around the far turn and faltered in the stretch. CHACHARERO failed to menace while racing two and three wide. COOL SLIPPERS (IRE) was bumped soon after the start, bumped again soon after, nearly unseating the rider and causing him to lose the right iron for a short period of time, became rank soon after, vied inside for a half and retreated around the far turn. CATCHHIMANDFREEHIM bumped with COOL SLIPPERS the first time through the stretch, chased the pace two wide and stopped around the far turn.
