FOREVER HOME stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, bid in late turn while still in the three path, gained the lead in upper stretch then drew away while being ridden out then geared down late. MONTGOMERY PARK set the pace from the two path while under pressure from the inside early, cleared in the turn while off the inside, was no match for the winner after straightening in the lane then stayed on to last for the place spot. JOAN'S WAY was in the two path through the turn when never far back, came into the lane from the four path, could not gain on the leader and just missed the place spot. SMOOTH LIKE ICE was in the two path through the turn, raced in the three path through the lane while offering a mild gain and moved up. BLOW SUM SMOKE chased the pace from the four path through the turn then weakened inside the eighth pole. MAMA LOU never a factor while in the three path through the turn. EASYONMYEYES no factor while in the three to the two path through the turn. MISS BETTE LUTE was fractious in the gate and had to be removed and reloaded, raced in the back while two wide and made no impact. SHAPE OF YOU pressed the early pace from the inside, chased through the turn then faded along the rail.
