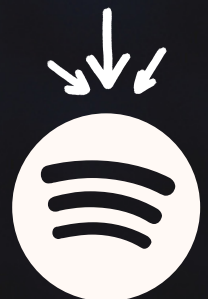

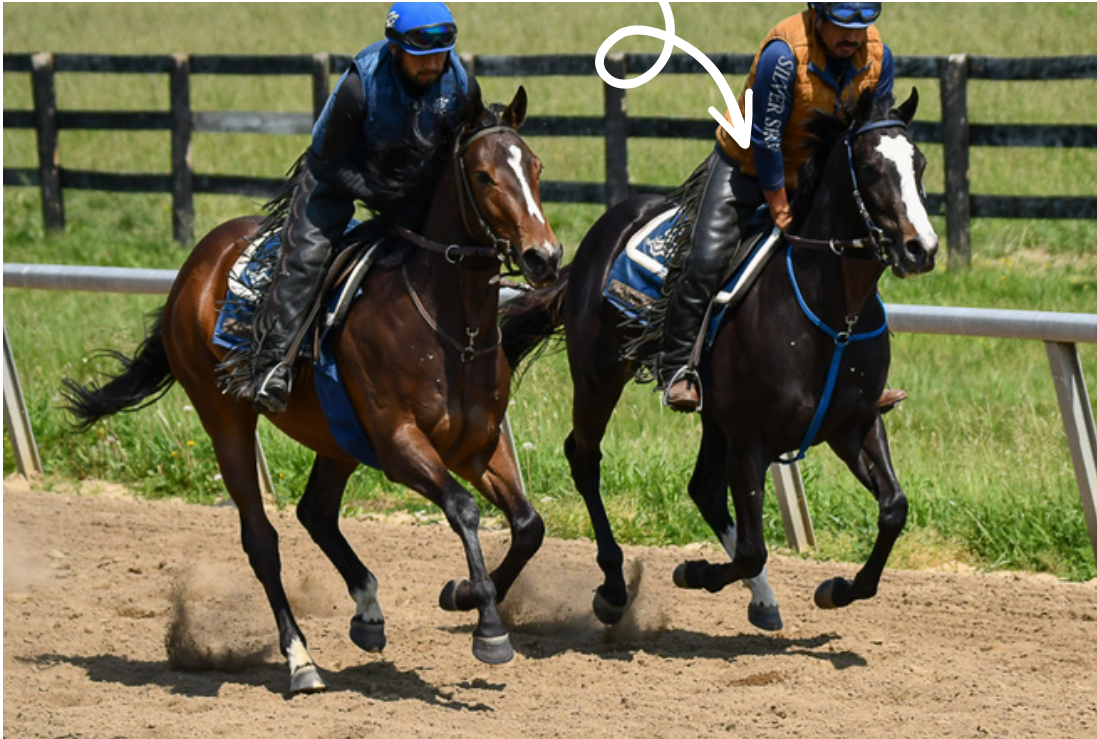

Malibu Moon x Believe In Me



It was all about the walk and athleticism with this filly as a yearling and it still is the case as a 2-year-old.

She was flagged by Jun Park (Knicks Go & Sibelius) back at the barns at Keeneland September and had a star by her hip number, indicating she was a standout even amongst the nice ones had on his short list.

Banshee Moon (a.k.a the Little Rocket Ship) is at Silver Springs Training Center in Lexington.

She is consistently producing very strong gallops, and is expected to breeze mid-July.

Ever the opinionated lady, they had to push back her initial breeze when she wouldn't change leads as they'd like her to.

Malibu Moon was a standout sire of more than 100 black-type stakes winners, 40 graded stakes winners and earners of nearly \$100 million. He has become a prominent broodmare sire. His notable progeny include Kentucky Derby winner Orb; Life at Ten; Devil May Care; Gormley; Carnina Mia; Ransom the Moon; and Stanford.

Believe In Me is a lightly raced Bodemeister mare who herself is out of Grade 1 Hollywood Starlet winner I Believe In You. Her half-sister is graded stakes placed Believe in A.P., who is by A.P. Indy.

Broken Vow x Good to Know



As a yearling, he was a very interesting physical being far from a typical Broken Vow, who was known to sire large, leggy horses that tended to be a touch coarse and were usually late to develop. He was an outstanding racehorse sire, but everyone knew you had to take your time with them.

This colt is much handier than your average Broken Vow and looks as though he'll be speedier and come to hand much quicker. He actually has more physical characteristics in common with dam sire, Candy Ride.

Oathbreaker has returned to the farm for some time to mature. We're not surprised that he needs a bit of a breather since he always struck us as a route-of-ground type horse anyway.

He'll return to his paces when he tells us he's ready.

Broken Vow sired 1,356 foals of racing age to date, getting an astounding 82% starters and 64% winners. He sired six champions including Champagne Room and Sassy Image as well as 79 other black type winners. To put it plainly, he simply threw good racehorses.

Good to Know did not race, but she is by the influential sire and perennial Top-20 broodmare sire, Candy Ride, whose leading earner as the BMS is Champion 3-year-old colt, Epicenter (by Not This Time).

Temple City x Mirabelle Magic, by Henny Hughes

Neither this filly, nor TCT are typical sales horses from a physical standpoint. Thus, we were able to get both at a tremendous value. Please be cautioned, we aren't in any way saying this filly is going to be the next Temple City Terror. They are just extremely similar.

The filly is very athletic. She has a very big walk and is an excellent mover. She has a big, deep girth and has turf route of ground written all over her. We look at every Temple City that goes through the ring these days and this is the first we've actually purchased since 2017.

She is happy, healthy and doing very well. They recently put her back under tack and she's thriving with the new workload.



Temple City is absolutely one of the best value sires in North America. He is one of the best turf sires year in and year out with graded stakes winners such as Miss Temple City, Bolo, Annals of Time, Kimbear and of course, Temple City Terror.

Mirabelle Magic was a two-time winner and in the money nine times from 19 starts. She is by Breeders' Cup Juvenile runner-up, and sire of Beholder, Henny Hughes. We really like the fact that he was bred to a speed-line mare. We're hopeful that will inject some speed into this filly like More Than Ready did for Temple City Terror.

Catalina Cruiser x Perfect Kay, by Kantharos

This Indiana-bred filly is by Catalina Cruiser. Though she has just started training, she's already got **a physique that catches the eye**. She's compact but very strong and athletic. Though it's impossible to predict, she looks like a turf sprinter. She's a little behind due to chip removal, but looks to be the type that will catch up in a hurry.

She'll race primarily at Horseshoe Indianapolis from April to November so we can take advantage of the **lucrative state restricted and bonus races**. She'll likely winter at Turfway Park and will be trained by Susan Anderson.

Perfect Kay 21 continues to impress the folks out at Silver Springs with her ability to pick up her lessons quickly. They're confident she will come to hand in no time at all once she gets on a breezing schedule.



Catalina Cruiser is a son of Union Rags out of Sea Gull, by Mineshaft. He was the winner of seven races including nine graded stakes from nine starts with earnings of \$711,100. He won graded stakes from 6.5 furlongs to 8.5 furlongs. His first foals are 2YOs which have averaged more than \$100,000 at the sales so far this year

Perfect Kay was a \$115,000 2YO purchase. She was a **stakes placed** winner at two and earned \$43,275 before her career was cut short.

Kantharos was 3 for 3 in his career with a pair of graded stakes sprint victories to his credit.
