CAPPY HOUR four wide first turn, dueled at half, cleared stretch, run down. VASILEVSKIY (IRE) off slow from the gate to trail, moved up steadily for show spot. HIGH POWERED saved ground in good position throughout with no late kick. DUDLEY inside sped to the front, pressured to the half with nothing left. BIG BLUE off slow from the gate, never menaced thereafter. TOPPING pressed pace between horses to the half, dropped back readily. FIRING RANGE dueled early on while giving way readily while far back stretch.
