(Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in estimating weight allowances.) Footnotes

NEVER EXPLAIN saved ground around the first turn, settled in the middle of the pack on the outside for the run up the backstretch, swung out to the five path to began a bid coming around the far turn and dueled to the finish to get up for the win late. RUNNING BEE raced in the two path early, stalked the leader on the outside up the backstretch, continued around the far turn in the four path, challenged approaching the quarter pole and dueled to the wire to narrowly miss. SIEGE OF BOSTON raced into traffic leaving the gate, moved out to the four path coming around the first turn, continued up the backstretch in the middle of the pack between horses, navigated the far bend still in the four path, began a bid passing the quarter pole and gained ground late. CHURCHTOWN saved ground around the first turn, chased the leader on the inside up the backstretch, continued to save ground around the second turn and kept on to the finish. IRISH ACES raced in the two and three path around the first bend, settled off the pace on the inside for the run up the backstretch, swung out to the five path coming around the far turn and improved position from there. OLYMPIC RUNNER raced in the middle of the pack on the outside

through the opening half mile, came around the second turn in the three path and was outkicked in the lane. WINFROMWITHIN saved ground around the first bend, led the way up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the two path and weakened in the final furlong. CANDIDATE raced in the two path early, tracked the leader between horses up the backstretch, navigated the turn from the three path and faded in the stretch. MOHS saved ground around the first turn, continued up the backstretch in the middle of the pack on the inside, came around the second turn in the two path and tired in the lane. APRIL FOOLS ANDY raced in the three path around the first turn, settled off the pace on the outside for the run up the backstretch, continued around the far turn in the four path and was empty in the stretch.
