I'M VERY BUSY rated off of the pace two to three wide and between horses, swung six wide entering upper stretch and rallied to sweep past the leader at the sixteenth pole. GIGANTE stalked along the inside around both turns, bid outside of the leader and gained an advantage entering the lane, but offered little resistance to an outer foe at the sixteenth pole and lasted for place. WEBSLINGER laid well back two wide and between horses, moved five wide entering the lane and offered a belated kick to reach show at the wire. BEATBOX pursued from the four path, crept closer around the far turn before floating five wide entering the lane, got outkicked by an outer rival in midstretch, ran on to attempt a late bid for show, but got outfinished by a wider bidder. STRONG QUALITY bobbled a bit at the start, showed the way in the three path early on, moved to the inside into the far turn, but was headed by a bidder entering the lane, yielded and lost show in the late stages. IRISH ACES pursued from midpack along the inside, briefly encountered traffic entering the lane in the two path, shifted in and ran on mildly. POINT PROVEN leaned in at the start, trailed in the two path, shifted to the five path into upper stretch and moved up between horses at the furlong grounds. ADHAMO (IRE) pursued from midpack in the two path, tracked along the inside around the far turn, hung on his left lead chasing in the three path through upper stretch, changed over at the furlong grounds but gave way between horses. PALAZZI broke slowly, saved ground well back, but to no avail. RISK MANAGER pursued from midpack three to four path, but floated seven wide entering the lane and faded. WOODS N WATER got hung in the five path while well back, floated eight wide entering the lane and made little impact. RISING EMPIRE tracked five wide,

stalked three deep around the far turn, but weakened between horses entering the lane. JOHNY'S FIREBALL stalked in the four to three path, but faded between horses turning for home.
