## Footnotes | <u>View Glossary Of Terms</u>

MY TULIP GAL hopped at the start, stalked in the four path, bid three wide passing the quarter, took the lead at the top of the lane, and drew clear. FOREVER HOPEFUL laid in midpack in the three path, ranged up four wide passing the quarter, and chased home the winner down the stretch for place. TEMPLE CITY MAGIC was wellback along the inside, advanced in the two path around the far turn, and kept on from along the rail down the lane for show. CACHACEIRA tracked inside, got stymied along the rail around the far turn, angled out to the seven path in upper stretch, and mildly gained late. CHAR chased in the two path, improved while under a ride out in the six path around the far turn, but faded in the stretch. MALICE MAMA bumped with an inner foe at the start, dueled for the lead in the three path but yielded down the lane. WILLFUL ROSE bumped with an outer foe at the start, vied for the lead in the two path but gaveway in the stretch. TATTLETALE raced off the pace in the two path and never threatened. JANIE'S DAYDREAM always trailed and was never involved.
