BHATIA stalked the pace in the three path, angled to the rail near the quarter pole, bid in the stretch and was clear late under a steady drive. PAYTON'S HAMMER stalked the pace in the four path, vied three wide in the stretch and was no match late while gaining the place. MR. ALL IN pressed the pace in the two path, bid near the quarter pole, led in the stretch but couldn't hold off the closers. EL TIO was unrushed early, moved to the four path near the quarter pole and improved position late. SENOR VALENTINE pressed the pace inside before giving way on the far turn. HYPERLINK saved ground, angled to the five path on the far turn but couldn't close late. AKKADIAN was squeezed back early, raced in the five path and faded. HICKMAN CREEK pressed the pace in the three path, was steadied near the quarter pole and gave way.
